Statement of Protest

Global Alliance Against Atrocity and Violence on Humanity (GA3VH)

Date: Sunday, 17 November

The Global Alliance Against Atrocity and Violence on Humanity (GA3VH) expresses deep concern, strong condemnation, and firm protest against the ruling declared by the so-called international tribunal against former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

Sentencing former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to death in her absence is not merely a judicial decision—it is a clear violation of international human rights standards, judicial ethics, and political neutrality.

This verdict demonstrates an abuse of power, retaliation, and politically motivated decision-making

Reasons for Opposing the Verdict

① The trial process was opaque and unusually rushed.

The tribunal was formed and the trial concluded within an unusually short period following the change in government, clearly indicating political motives.

② Turning an accused into a state witness is unlawful and unethical.

This violates the principles of voluntary testimony, judicial integrity, and internationally accepted legal norms.

③ The scope of the trial was deliberately restricted.

Although the period 2009–2025 was brought under trial, previous years' unresolved killings, disappearances, torture, and political violence were completely ignored.



④ Death toll figures in the July incident remain unverified.

The claim of 1,400 deaths has not been supported by any independent, international, or transparent investigation.

⑤ International human rights organizations have not endorsed the verdict.

The UN and Amnesty International have already expressed concern and issued formal objections.

GA3VH Demands

GA3VH urgently calls for the following measures:

Immediate suspension and review of the verdict

Formation of an independent, international, and neutral investigation commission

An end to the use of the justice system as a tool of political retaliation

Ensuring democratic rights, rule of law, and the protection of human rights.

GA3VH Position

This verdict does not reflect justice —

It is a manifestation of fear, power consolidation, and political vengeance.

GA3VH firmly declares that such judicial decisions are contrary to human rights, justice, and democratic values.
